#### What is Meals on Wheels?

Meals on Wheels is a non-profit community service under the direction of a Board of Directors composed of lay personnel, the Meals on Wheels staff person and a Hendricks Regional Health representative. The entire board is concerned with the welfare and well being of people.

This program assists people in improving the quality of their lives and in maintaining their dignity and independence within the security of their own homes.

# Who Prepares the Meals?

The Nutrition and Dietetics Department of Hendricks Regional Health prepares meals. All meals are prepared under the direction of a Registered Dietitian in accordance with a written diet order approved by the client's physician.

Meals contain one-third of the minimum daily nutritional requirements for adults. Special diets are available as needed.

### When are Meals Delivered?

Meals are delivered Monday through Friday (no weekends) as close to noon as possible. Meals on Wheels does not deliver on holidays, including New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

#### **How Much Does it Cost?**

Meals on Wheels charges clients a minimal cost for the service. The income covers the meal cost and part of the office operating expenses. Other expenses are covered by donations from individuals and corporations. Volunteers donate the cost of delivery.

Daily delivery for five days:
One hot meal \$21.25
Two meals – one hot/one cold \$37.50

Prices are subject to change with notice.
