Additionally, MSD Wayne Townships nurses will get access to education and training through the Hendricks School Nursing program.

Through this partnership:

- Wayne Township student-athletes will have access to a full circle of care in orthopedics, sports medicine and rehabilitation from Hendricks
- Wayne Township school staff, spouses and dependents covered by the health plan will have access to an additional four wellness clinics with a concierge approach to scheduling, referrals and supportive resources
- Hendricks pediatricians will assume medical oversight of Wayne Township school nurse clinics to continue the top-level care to all students
- Wayne Township nurses will be able to take advantage of professional development opportunities through the Hendricks School Nursing program
