## **Hendricks Regional Health Offers Back-To-School Vaccinations for 6<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Students in Avon and Brownsburg Schools**

Danville - As the next school year draws closer, doctors' offices swell with an influx of children and their parents for a variety of reasons from physicals, to check-ups, to receiving vaccinations. To assist families of Avon and Brownsburg students in ensuring their children's vaccinations are up to date before the school year begins, Hendricks Regional Health is offering several clinics.

Vaccinations that will be offered include:

- Hepatitis A (*required for 6<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades*)
- Meningococcal Conjugate (MCV4) (*required for 6<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades*)
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) (*required for 6<sup>th</sup> grade*)
- Meningitis B (*recommended for 12<sup>th</sup> grade*)
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV) (*recommended for 6<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade*)

For the convenience of families with students entering 6<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades at Avon and Brownsburg schools, these clinics will be held at the schools during registration days.

- July 18 at Avon High School, 9 a.m. – 7 p.m.
- July 25 at Avon High School, 9 a.m. – 7 p.m.
- July 26 at Avon Intermediate West, 11 a.m. – 6 p.m.
- July 26 at Brownsburg Middle East, 11 a.m. – 6 p.m.
- July 26 at Brownsburg Middle West, 11 a.m. – 6 p.m.
- July 27 at Brownsburg High School, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.
- July 30 at Brownsburg High School, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

Preregistration is not required. Parents must be present for students younger than 18 years old. If insurance will cover the vaccinations, please bring an insurance card for Hendricks Regional Health to use for billing. Hendricks Regional Health will also accept self-pay checks; cash payments will not be available.
