Kevin Speer, JD, Resigns as Hendricks Regional Health President & CEO

DANVILLE, Indiana — After serving Hendricks Regional Health for over 10 years, Kevin Speer, JD, has resigned as President & CEO to assume leadership of Ascension St. Vincent Indiana.

With Speer at the helm, Hendricks has strategically grown services for west central Indiana including cardiology, breast oncology, critical care and more. Under his leadership Hendricks built its second hospital, earned the honor of joining the Mayo Clinic Care Network, and implemented Epic electronic medical record system. Speer led the organization through the transition from 27 separate electronic medical record systems to one unified platform, making patient care at Hendricks forever safer.

During Speer's tenure, the number of employed providers at Hendricks has grown by nearly 200 percent, adding unprecedented local access to care. In addition, Hendricks has become nationally recognized in quality and safety by Leapfrog, Healthgrades and others.

Throughout the tumultuous days of COVID, Speer was an unwavering voice of leadership, support and reassurance for his team and the community. He also led the culture-building initiative to define the Hendricks core values and officially roll out The Hendricks Way.
