

Optical Policy

As an Ophthalmology practice our focus is treating medical problems of the eye and not routine eye exams, glass/contact prescriptions or glasses adjustment. We do not perform refractions, exams that check for glasses/contact prescriptions, unless we need to for medical treatment.

Most medical plans do not cover the cost of refractions. If we must perform a refraction for medical purposes, you may be required to pay for that part of your visit.

If we must perform a refraction for medical purposes and you choose to obtain your prescription through an online service, we cannot be responsible for any quality or accuracy problems that may occur. If you require additional services to determine the source of the problem, there will be additional fees that will not be covered under insurance.

If you require a routine eye exam, glasses/contact prescription or glasses adjustment, we will be happy to refer you to an Optometrist that can provide these services for you.
