Thank you for your interest in the Hendricks Regional Health Fall/Winter Emergency Medical Technician program. Attached is an application for admission as well as a request for references. Please complete in its entirety the application and have your references mail or email me their recommendation. The program is a first come first serve entry to the first 20 applicants. Should more than 20 applications be received, a waiting list will be initiated. All students shall submit to the program

State of Indiana "Limited History Report" which is located on the Indiana State Police Website [www.in.gov/isp](http://www.in.gov/isp). This report is at the student's expense.

A valid American Heart Association **BLS Healthcare Provider** CPR card. For those student who do not have this certification, the class will be held during the first 2 or 3 days of the class. An additional nominal fee may be charged.

The cost for the program is \$800.00 with \$400.00 due on the first day of the class. Payments for the remaining balance can be made while the class is in session. All monies due must be paid prior to 30 days from the end of the program. Checks need to be made payable to: **Hendricks Regional Health**. In the additional information section please list EMS programs Attn: Michael Wolfe. If you are needing to charge the cost of the class, please contact the hospital's cashier only after acceptance in to the program. Contact information will be given on acceptance into the program.

The cost includes

- Two (2) uniform T-shirts (needed for class and clinicals)
- HRH hosted State of Indiana Psychomotor testing fees

Start date for the class is November 8, 2022, with an estimated end date of May 2, 2023. Classes will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6pm - 10pm at the Plainfield Fire Territory Headquarter Building, 591 Moon Rd., Plainfield IN. 46168. Clinicals are self-scheduled around class days. Students must attend one (1) 12-hour field internship clinical with one of our sponsored fire departments and one (1) 8-hour Emergency Room hospital clinical at Hendricks Regional Health each month starting in December 2022. Additional online education is required to comply with State of Indiana regulations and National Education Standards for EMS. These educational needs will be discussed on the first day of class, as well as course expectations.
