EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN FALL 2024 PROGRAM

Thank you for your interest in the Hendricks Regional Health Fall 2024 Emergency Medical Technician program. Attached is an application for admission. Please complete in its entirety the application, recommendations are not necessary. The program is a first come first serve entry to the first 20 applicants. Should more than 20 applications be received, a waiting list will be initiated. All students shall submit to the program

A State of Indiana "Limited Criminal History Report" is required. This is located on the Indiana State Police Website www.in.gov/isp. This report is at the student's expense.

A valid American Heart Association **BLS Healthcare Provider** CPR card is mandatory.

The cost for the program is \$900.00 with \$400.00 due on the first day of the class. Payments for the remaining balance can be made while the class is in session. All monies due must be paid by 30 days prior to the end of the program. Checks need to be made payable to: **Hendricks Regional Health**. If you are wishing to charge the cost of the class, please contact the hospital's cashier (317)745-3506 **only after acceptance into the program**.

The cost of the program includes:

- Textbook
- Online Course material
- Online Scheduling for Clinicals and Field Internship
- Online Skills tracking
- Two (2) uniform T-shirts (needed for class and clinicals)
- HRH hosted State of Indiana Psychomotor testing fees

Start date for the class is August 13, 2024, with an estimated end date of March 13, 2025. Classes will be conducted on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6pm-10pm.

During the program, students must also attend 24-hour field internship clinicals with one of our sponsored fire departments and 16 hours in one of Emergency Departments in addition to the scheduled class time.



Prior to the start of the class there are items that you will need to complete for the State of Indiana.

To register with the State of Indiana for the class, which is **mandatory**, you will need to go to obtain an Indiana Public Safety ID (PSID) number, this application can be found at <https://secure.in.gov/dhs/3880.htm>.

Once you have been issued a PSID, you will need to create an Indiana ACADIS account.

This is located at <https://acadisportal.in.gov/AcadisViewer/Login.aspx>.

Once you have that account, go to the Training & Events tab select Browse or Sign Up for Training. Make sure that there are no checked boxes in the “Refine Your Search” area. Scroll down the course until you find

Once you are enrolled in the course on ACADIS, you will be assigned the mandatory training modules for the State of Indiana. You will complete those inside the ACADIS portal. These training modules are

- Physicians Out of Hospital Scope of Practice (POST)
- Violation Statement
- Suicide Prevention
- Autism Awareness

You will also need to obtain a FEMA Student ID number. This can be found <https://cdp.dhs.gov/femasid/register>. You will need this number to complete

IS100, 200, 700, 800. These can be found at <https://training.fema.gov/is/crslist.aspx> Search for each course and register.
