



## Hendricks Regional Health Fair Practices

### **Americans with Disabilities Act:**

All persons requesting enrollment for the Hendricks Regional Health Paramedic Program are required to complete an application. Applicants are considered on the basis of their qualifications without regard to race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin or ancestry, disability, political affiliation, uniformed service status, sexual orientation, or any other protected status or characteristic, in accordance with applicable federal, state and local laws.

### **Withdraw:**

Students may withdraw from the program at any time. Students who withdraw from the program within two weeks from the start of the program may be entitled to a full refund of funds paid. To be eligible for full refunds all material issued must be returned in a new, unopened condition. All computer codes must be unused.

### **Advanced Placement:**

The Hendricks Community Paramedic Science Program does not offer credit for advanced placement credit classes previously completed.

### **Transfer of Credits:**

The Hendricks Community Paramedic Science Program does not offer the ability to transfer credits for classes previously completed.

### **Experiential Learning:**

The Hendricks Community Paramedic Science Program does not offer credit for experiential learning credit.

### **Course Completion Requirements:**

All students accepted must complete each module of the program with at least a 75% grade for each module and successfully complete the Field Internship Capstone requirements to be eligible to participate in the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians Paramedic Psychomotor and Cognitive exams.

### **Licensure:**

Graduates who successfully complete the testing components administered by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians may apply for licensure through reciprocity through the State of Indiana Emergency Medical Services Commission.

### **Articulation of Credits:**

Hendricks Regional Health Paramedic Program has entered into an Articulation Agreement to allow graduates of the Hendricks Regional Health Paramedic program who have successfully obtained licensure in the State of Indiana 47.5 credit hours when enrolled into an Ivy Tech Community College approved program.
