At Hendricks Regional Health, our culture is built around a legacy of community service. We are honored to support our family, friends and neighbors in the region through outreach, health education, wellness screenings, youth enrichment and community sponsorships.

HENDRICKS CARES

Hendricks Cares represents our associate volunteer program which focuses on bringing the Hendricks Regional Health values to life. It enables our team members to make a difference in the community through our aligned partners and to proudly represent Hendricks Regional Health at fun, interactive events.





LEGACY OF GIVING GALA

This annual event supports the Hendricks Regional Health Foundation's mission to raise awareness of, and provide support for, initiatives to enhance community health, patient comfort, safety and medical care at Hendricks Regional Health. Past galas have supported initiatives such as the Mobile Telestroke Program and the HendricksGO!

transport program. In 2018, we raised \$450,000 for our Community Paramedicine Program.

GOVERNOR'S LUNCHEON

Hendricks Regional Health was proud to serve as the Presenting Sponsor for the Governor's Luncheon in 2018. With more than 2,000 attendees, this signature event raised \$1,024,854 to benefit Scouting in Central Indiana. As part of the program, President & CEO Kevin Speer shared his experiences of how Scouting has positively changed his life in front of the sell-out event.



GIRL SCOUTS' LEADERSHIP LUNCHEON

Hendricks Regional Health is proud to sponsor and support the Girl Scouts' mission of building girls of courage, confidence and character. This event helps to support the 29,000 youths served by the Girl Scouts of Central Indiana through scholarships and program assistance.

YOUTH ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

Hendricks Regional Health aims to provide various opportunities for aspiring healthcare professionals in the community, including:

- 75 annual healthcare job shadow experiences provided to local students
- 20 youth volunteers (under age 18) currently active
- 19 paid internships provided to local students in 2018



IMAGINATION LAB

Hendricks Regional Health's initiative with Plainfield Community School Corporation serves to promote interactive learning and foster an interest in the medical field. Several of our interns focus part of their summer on creating a hands-

on learning exhibit to share with children visiting the Lab.

A DAY AT THE HOSPITAL

Hendricks Regional Health invites local first grade classes from Hendricks and surrounding counties to visit our Danville campus. These educational tours can help alleviate fear and anxiety about being a patient or visiting someone who is hospitalized.

HENDRICKS REGIONAL HEALTH YMCA

Hendricks Regional Health has partnered with the YMCA of Greater Indianapolis to offer a fully-integrated YMCA and health system collaboration in Avon. This

central hub of health and wellness is meant to break down barriers to a healthy lifestyle by forming a complete circle of care for people of all ages and activity levels. Here, people can access everything one needs for prevention, treatment and maintenance of a healthy life.

MEALS ON WHEELS

Meals on Wheels is a non-profit organization that promotes good health and independence while easing loneliness for homebound seniors in our community. Hendricks Regional Health has a team of registered dietitians that plan and prepare meals that volunteers then deliver to those who cannot prepare meals for themselves due to illness, disability or age.

HEALTH EVENTS & SCREENINGS

Hendricks Regional Health provides a wide array of educational health events and classes, such as Childbirth & Parenting classes, CPR classes, Safe Sitter classes, community and wellness classes and support groups.



CHILL & GRILL EVENTS

These events serve as an appreciation program for our community's first responders and law enforcement officers. Each summer, leaders from Hendricks Regional Health visit fire houses and police stations in our area to cook lunch as a way

to personally thank them for their selfless service to our community. Since 2016, Hendricks has hosted more than 60 Chill & Grill events while serving over 1,800 meals for our local heroes.

EMPLOYER & SCHOOL PARTNERSHIPS

Hendricks Regional Health has the privilege and honor of partnering with over 400 local employers, providing wellness centers, custom health plan networks, occupational health service and nationally recognized wellness programming. Our local partnerships ensure that 100 percent of the public high schools in Hendricks and Putnam Counties have access to athletic trainers.





HENDRICKS COUNTY 4-H FAIR

Hendricks Regional Health is proud to be the exclusive healthcare partner of the Hendricks County Fair, which attracts 55,000 Hendricks County residents each year. We host booths and interactive games that provide health education to Fair attendees. In addition, our Emergency Department staff and their Emergency Medical

Services partners coordinate a first aid clinic and comprehensive medical coverage to keep everyone safe and comfortable throughout the week.

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Hendricks Regional Health is proud to continue to serve as the premier sponsor of four Hendricks County-based home builds by providing \$20,000 in cash support annually. In addition, each year we recruit more than 60 associate volunteers to commit over 400 hours of community service to help deserving families realize their dream of home ownership.



HEALTHCARE EXPLORERS PROGRAM

The Healthcare Explorers Program is for students ages 14 to 20 who would like an in-depth, hands-on experience in the realm of healthcare. Students learn about different professions within our health system, and are engaged with activities, games, presentations and opportunities to closely interact with healthcare professionals.



FAMILY PROMISE

Hendricks Regional Health serves as a host site for Family Promise, an organization that aims to achieve sustainable independence for families experiencing homelessness or poverty in Hendricks County. We work towards ending homelessness in our community by providing a home to families in need while they work to achieve greater stability.

NINE13SPORTS KIDS RIDING BIKES®

Hendricks Regional Health's largest community partnership is our exclusive sponsorship with Nine13sports to help combat childhood obesity. Through this program, Hendricks Regional Health supplements physical education curriculum at every K-8 school in Hendricks and Putnam Counties while serving 7,500 unique students each academic year. In addition, the bicycle simulator programming makes 25 community appearances each year to promote the importance of health, wellness and exercise for local youth.

CYPRESS MANOR

Hendricks Regional Health oversees the operation and preservation of Cypress Manor, a 150-year old residential care facility that exists to serve indigent residents in Hendricks County. Our associates actively volunteer to help improve the grounds and support programs that enhance quality of life for the residents.
